EVENT DAY TIMELINE

- 4:00 PM: Parking Lots & Ticket Trailer Open
- 5:00 PM: Coach USA Bus service from NYC Port Authority begins
- 6:31 PM: NJ TRANSIT Rail service from Secaucus begins (June 25 & 27)
- 7:00 PM: Stadium Gates open (enter early to avoid delays at the gates)
- 9:00 PM: Match Begins

Parking / Personal Vehicle Drop-Off – If driving, carpooling is encouraged due to limited parking for this event

Lots Open: 4:00 PM

Parking Fee: \$40 per standard sized vehicle; \$160 per bus/RV/oversized vehicle

Payment Options: Credit cards and cash accepted at entry plazas; have payment ready as you enter Tailgating Policy: Tailgating is permitted (one car, one space), click here for all rules/policies

Drop-Off Area: Personal Vehicle Drop-Off area is on the roadway between Parking Lots D & E

NJ TRANSIT Rail Service - Recommended due to limited parking for this event, especially on Tuesday, June 25

- NJ TRANSIT Rail service from Secaucus Junction TO MetLife Stadium via the Meadowlands Line:
 - Service runs to the stadium from 6:31 PM to 9:55 PM on both June 25 & June 27; Full Schedule
- Post-match, service will run FROM MetLife Stadium to Secaucus Junction; last train doesn't depart before 1:00 AM
- Purchase your round-trip tickets in advance via the NJ TRANSIT Mobile App to avoid long lines and delays

Coach USA Bus Service - 351 Meadowlands Express - Recommended due to limited parking for this event

- Will operate from NYC Port Authority direct to MetLife Stadium on both June 25 & June 27 from 5:00 PM 8:15 PM, departing from 41st Street between 8th & 9th Avenues
- The last bus will leave the stadium to return to NYC Port Authority 60 minutes after the match ends
- Round-trip tickets are \$14 and are available for purchase at 351 Meadowlands Express

Rideshare

- Designated rideshare (Uber, Lyft, etc.) pick-up/drop-off location is in Lot E
- Rideshare surge pricing is often in effect after the event; public transportation is recommended
- Larger crowds will result in longer than usual wait times for a car to arrive after the match (may be 1-2 hours depending on crowd size); please explore public transportation options and avoid rideshare if possible

ALCOHOL SALES – INTERNATIONAL GUESTS

- The legal drinking age in the United States is 21
- ALL guests who appear to be under the age of 40 are subject to age verification
- International guests must present a valid passport or passport card to purchase alcohol per New Jersey State Law
- MetLife Stadium cannot accept a driver's license from another country to establish proof of age

TICKETING

- Box Office/Ticketmaster Will-Call: Located at trailer outside MetLife Gate Opens at 4:00 PM
- All guests over 34 inches tall must have their own ticket
- No re-entry: if you leave the Stadium, you will not be allowed to re-enter

Mobile Ticketing:

- Your ticket must be displayed on your phone to enter the event (tickets will not be emailed / available to print)
- Barcodes for ticket scanning will appear on mobile tickets 8 hours prior to the event
- Please have your mobile ticket downloaded before you enter the security line
- How To Display Mobile Tickets On Your Phone:
 - Download the Ticketmaster App
 - o Find your mobile tickets in "My Events," and transfer a ticket to each person in your party
 - Everyone should add their ticket to their phone's wallet before approaching the entry gate
 - Display your mobile ticket at entry and you're in!

CLEAR BAG POLICY IS IN EFFECT!

- Clear bags of any style 12" x 6" x 12" or smaller are allowed
- Bags must be completely clear plastic and free of color tint or pattern
- Non-clear small purses/wallets no larger than 4.5" x 6.5" also permitted

SECURITY SCREENING

- All guests will be subject to a courteous screening via a walk-through metal detector at the stadium gates
- Guests must place their cell phones, keys, and metal objects on the security table before walking through the metal detector
- · Belts and jewelry do not need to be removed
- Guests should only bring items they absolutely need inside the stadium



PERMITTED ITEMS - All items are subject to inspection upon entry

- Point & shoot, non-professional cameras (no case or detachable lens)
- Official national flags that can be reasonably hand-held by a single person (not hung on any surface)
- Handheld signs/banners no larger than 11" x 17" (cannot be mounted to a pole/stick, obstruct the view of others, or be commercial in nature)
- Open drums no larger than 12"x12"x12" (no closed drums)
- Ponchos or raincoats (NO umbrellas)

- Factory sealed canned or plastic water/soft-drink bottles 20 oz. or less
- Empty reusable water bottle (plastic or aluminum) no larger than 20 oz.
- Food in a clear plastic bag or wrapping
- Medically necessary items
- Small, hand-held USB-charged personal fans
- Small portable phone chargers
- Binoculars (not contained in a case)

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- NO noisemakers, instruments, or vuvuzelas
- NO professional or semi-professional cameras, video cameras, Go Pro's, or selfie sticks
- NO audio or recording equipment such as iPads, tablets, computers, etc.
- NO non-clear bag exceeding 4.5" x 6.5" in size
- NO outside alcohol of any kind
- NO drones

- NO glass bottles, coolers, thermoses or ice chests
- NO weapons or projectile of any kind
- NO umbrellas, strollers, laser pointers, balls of any kind
- NO seat cushions (except those for medical needs)

CONTACTLESS AND CASHLESS PAYMENTS ONLY

- MetLife Stadium operates cash-free; only contactless payment options will be accepted inside the Stadium (cash or credit cards may be used at the parking toll entrances only)
- Pay with a debit or credit card (Visa is the preferred card of MetLife Stadium, Mastercard, AMEX, Discover)
- Mobile payment, including Apple Pay and Google Pay, is accepted
- Reverse ATMs are available onsite to load cash onto a prepaid Visa debit card valid for in-stadium purchases

CELL PHONE CHARGING KIOSKS

- Mobile charging kiosks are available in the following locations for mobile devices in need of a boost:
 - Outside the gates: Bag check trailers at all entrance gates and in the Lot E Rideshare Lot
 - Plaza Level: West and East VIP Lobbies
 - o 100 Concourse: near Sections 124 and 149
 - o 200 Concourse: Section 227, Miller Lite MVP Club elevator lobby, Corona Beach Club elevator lobby
 - o **300 Concourse:** near Sections 302, 324, 328 & 349
 - o **Ticketmaster Suites**: West and East Concierge Desks on the 3rd, 5th, and 6th Floors
